

Free Daisy Square Crochet Bag Pattern



Get ready to create a beautiful **boho-style crochet bag** that's perfect for summer festivals, beach days, or everyday use.

This beginner-friendly project uses classic **granny square techniques** combined with a textured daisy design to create a stylish and functional accessory.

Materials & Tools

Yarn (Worsted Weight / Size 4):

Choose 4 colors:

- **Color A:** Mustard (flower center + accent round)
- **Color B:** White (petals)
- **Color C:** Sage Green (inner square)
- **Color D:** Brown (outer border + strap)

Hook: 5 mm (H/8)

Other Supplies:

- Scissors
- Tapestry needle

- Button (for closure)

Gauge: Not important for this project

Stitch Guide (US Terms)

- **ch** – chain
- **st** – stitch
- **sl st** – slip stitch
- **dc** – double crochet
- **hdc** – half double crochet
- **tr** – treble crochet
- **yo** – yarn over

Special Stitch: 3 Treble Crochet Cluster

This creates the daisy petals.

Steps:

1. Yarn over twice (yo twice)
2. Insert hook into stitch
3. Yo, pull up loop
4. Yo, pull through 2 loops (repeat twice) → 2 loops remain
5. Repeat steps 1–4 two more times in same stitch
6. Yo, pull through all loops on hook

Daisy Square (Make 2 Squares)



Each square $\approx 10'' \times 10''$

Round 1 (Color A – Center)

1. Chain 4 and join with sl st to form a ring
(or use magic circle)
2. Ch 3 (counts as first tr)
3. Make **11 tr into ring** (12 total stitches)
4. Join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 2 (Color B – Petals)

1. Attach yarn in any stitch
2. First petal:
 - Ch 4
 - Work partial cluster in same stitch
 - Yo, pull through all loops
3. Remaining petals:
 - Ch 2, make 3 tr cluster in next stitch
 - Repeat around

You should have:

- **12 petals**
- **12 chain-2 spaces**

4. Join with sl st and fasten off

Round 3 (Color C – Shape into Square)

1. Attach yarn in any space between petals
2. Ch 3, make 2 tr in same space
3. Repeat:
 - 3 dc in next space
 - 3 dc in next space
 - Corner: *(3 tr, ch 2, 3 tr)*
4. Repeat pattern around to form square
5. Join with sl st

Round 4 (Color C)

1. Ch 2, 1 dc in same corner
2. Dc in each stitch across
3. In each corner: *(2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc)*
4. Join with sl st

Round 5 (Color A)

Repeat **Round 4** using Color A

Rounds 6 & 7 (Color D)

Repeat **Round 4** for both rounds

Round 8 (Color D – Final Edge)

1. Ch 1, 1 hdc in same corner
2. Hdc across each stitch
3. In corners: *(2 hdc, ch 2, 2 hdc)*

4. Join and fasten off

Weave in all ends

Assemble the Bag

1. Place both squares together:
 - **Right sides facing outward**
2. Using Color D:
 - Join yarn at top corner
 - Slip stitch through both layers
3. Continue joining:
 - Down one side
 - Across bottom
 - Up the other side
4. Leave the **top open**

Make the Strap



Approx. length: **20 inches**

Row 1 (Color D)

- Chain 130
- Single crochet (sc) across
- Fasten off

Row 2 (Color A)

- Attach yarn
- Ch 1, sc across
- Fasten off

Row 3 (Color C)

- Repeat Row 2

Row 4 (Color D)

- Repeat Row 2

Attach Strap

1. Locate side seams of bag
2. Position strap:
 - Centered over seams
 - Ends extend **1–1.5 inches inside bag**
3. Sew securely:
 - Stitch along edges and bottom of strap ends

Add Closure

- Sew a **button** to top center
- Optional: add loop on opposite side

Final Notes

- Perfect **stash-buster project**
- Customize with:
 - Bright festival colors

- Neutral earthy tones

Tips for Beginners

- Count stitches each round to avoid mistakes
- Use stitch markers for corners
- Keep tension consistent for even squares
